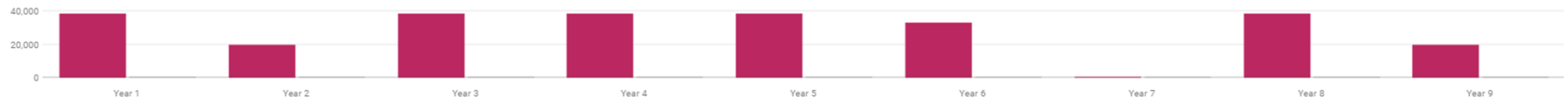

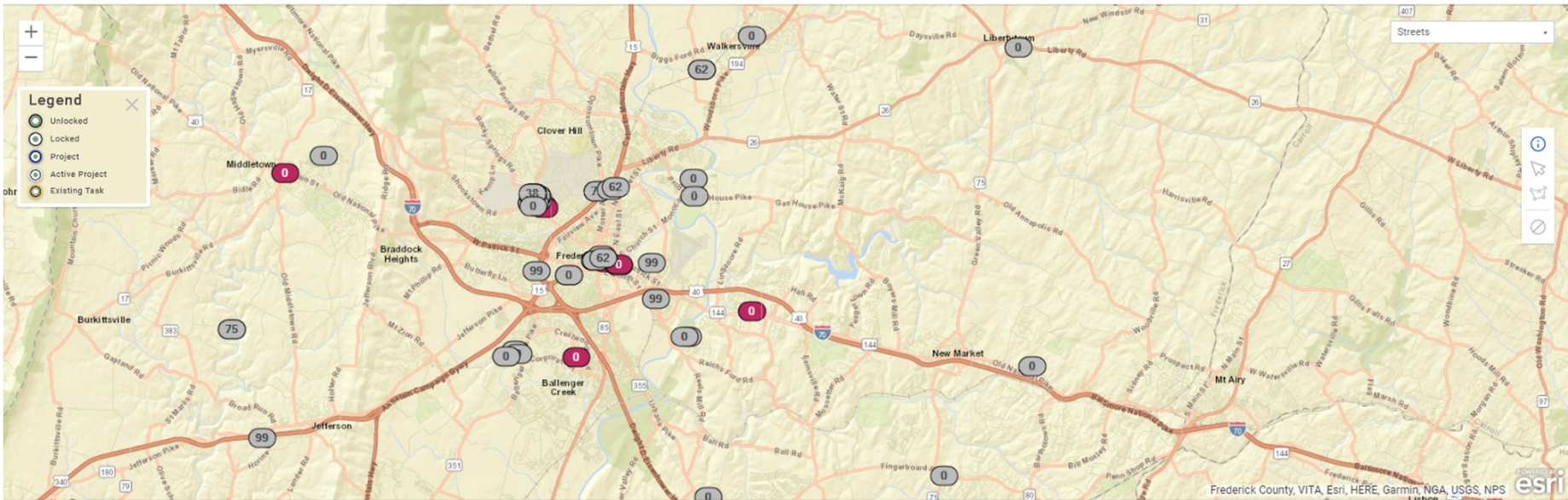
Activity Cost Per Plan Year

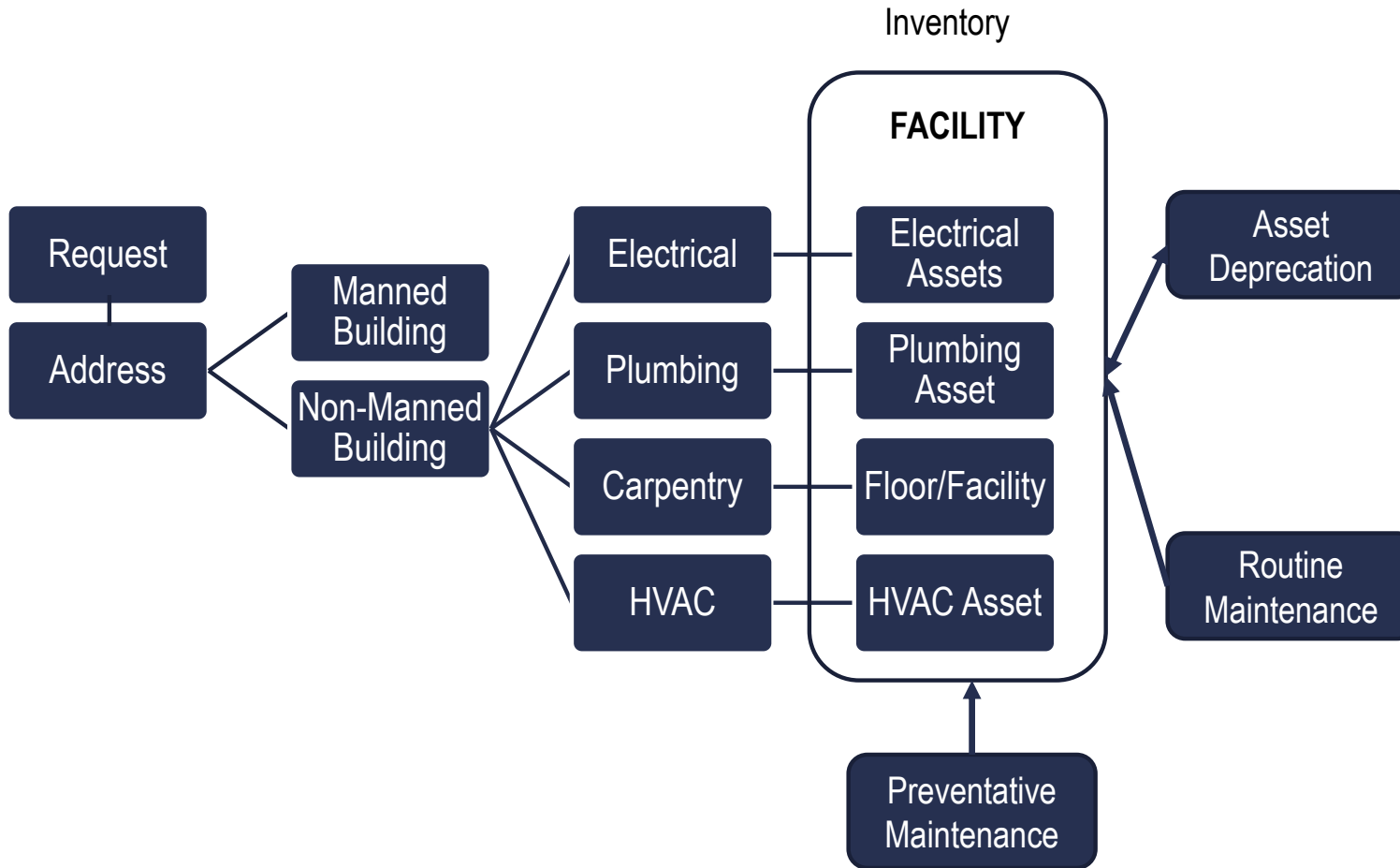

A registered professional engineer since 1986, Mr. Ennis has worked for Frederick County Public Works for almost 28 years in various positions from plan review to managing capital projects for buildings, parks and MS4 compliance.

During a major reorganization in 2012, his responsibilities transferred to the maintenance side of the operation, becoming responsible for the maintenance of over 170 County buildings. With a second reorganization the following year, the Office of Highway Operations was added to his job responsibilities. It was during this transition that he began to investigate the implementation of asset management to track and schedule maintenance and replacement of systems and components. When the County decided on a County wide, holistic approach to asset management in 2019, Mr. Ennis was part of the selection committee that evaluated various products on the market that ultimately led to the procurement of Cartegraph Asset Management in 2020. Mr. Ennis was involved with the phased implementation of Cartegraph for both Maintenance and Highway Operations.

Abstract

Frederick County Implementation of Cartegraph

List brief overview of presentation in bulletized format

- Frederick County purchased Cartegraph in August 2020 for the management and tracking of work against County owned assets. By July 2022, 4 divisions and 350 users were tracking work on 133 different asset types that covered over 270,000 assets owned by the County. This presentation will focus on the Division of Public's Work successful implementation and how this tool has helped streamline internal and regulatory reporting, its ability to track constituent requests, broken down by Facility or Highways Districts, the Division's responses, the swift distribution of interdepartmental requests, and the opportunities for growth and engagement with the next generation of Public Work employees.
